The purpose of this video is to introduce JICA Scholars the internationalization and modernization of Japanese horticulture set in Yokohama, through the history of the development of Horticulture.

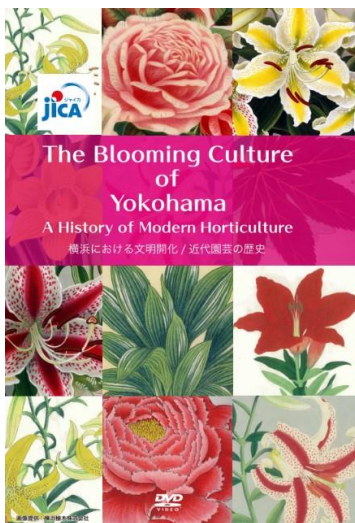
