Contribute to strengthening the agricultural extension system in Mozambique by training the agricultural extension officers



Development Issues / Background

- About 70% of the population of Mozambique (2021) lives in rural areas, most of whom are engaged in agriculture.
- Most of the farmers are family-run small-scale farmers, and due to the low-input and low-productivity farming style, the agricultural value added per agricultural worker is about USD 397/year (2017).
- There are about 4,000 agricultural extension officers (2020) in 154 districts nationwide, who needs opportunities to strengthen their capacity.

Expected Impact on the Agriculture Sector

- 60 agricultural extension officers strengthen their capacity through training in Japan
- The results of the training, such as the implementation of the action plan created through the training, will be applied in field to guide small-scale farmers.
