Development Issues / Background

- In Mozambique, registered Small and Medium-sized Enterprises SMEs accounted for 98.6% of all registered companies and they are the principal players of local industrial development.
- To reduce regional disparities and promote employment, it is a priority to promote local industries utilizing the rich resources of each region.
- It is expected that the local industry development system will be further strengthened based on potential approach such as Kaizen.

Expected Impact on the Industry Sector

- 300 SME's receives training and among them 60 is supported directly by the project team to concretize their business plan.
- In the target area, the actors (the SMEs supported by the projects, financial institutions etc.) are connected to each other creating a qualified network for strengthening the ecosystem of local industry
- Good examples of ecosystem are created in each target area.
