- Project Overview: Increase the rice productivity in 6 districts of ٠ Zambezia Province and improve the livelihood of farmers in the target areas.



Development Issues / Background

 Although main crops of the country are cassava and maize, in late years, growth of rice consumption has been dramatic and it increased a lot, in fact 60% of rice consumption in the country is covered by imports.

 In order to improve rice self sufficiency rate, intensification of rice production in the country is an urgent need.

 There are some constraints such as lack of ability of production management, which affects all the value chain of rice.

Expected Impact on the Agriculture Sector

 The project will help the Government of Mozambigue increasing the rice productivity in order to reduce the imports.

 Particularly in Zambezia Province the rice productivity in rain fed and irrigated areas will double and by promoting linkages with local markets the income of rice farmers will increase
