

(2) Dispatch of Volunteers

JICA has dispatched 753 volunteers to Fiji since July 1983. Under the COVID-19 situation, all JICA Volunteers were repatriated to Japan. To date, JICA has resumed the Volunteer program in May 2022 and recruitment of new volunteers. From May 2023, several volunteers were dispatched to the Western Region of Viti Levu and are it is planned to start dispatching to Vanua Levu in 2024.

3. Others

SDGs Global Leaders Program (Formerly known as Pacific-LEADS)

Scholarships to study at Japanese Universities (Bachelor, Master & PhD Courses) are offered under SDGs Global Leaders Program (Known as Pacific-LEADS) which was committed at the 7th Pacific Islands Leaders Meeting (PALM7) in 2015. To date, 45 students have been dispatched from Fiji under this programme.
