 Project Overview: Construction of water supply systems and deep wells with handpump to improve access to safe water



Development Issues / Background

- Mozambique lacks water facilities to provide safe water, and water supply rate needs to be improved.
- Water supply rate in Niassa province (37%) was lower than national average (56%) according to **DNAAS 2015.**
- Together with JICA's technical cooperation project "Project on Promoting Sustainability of Water Supply System and Sanitation in Niassa Province" from 2021-2026, this project aims at providing safe water to people in Niassa province.

Expected Impact on the Water Sector

- 4 water supply systems and 100 deep wells with handpump constructed, through which more than 86,000 people will benefit from safe drinking water.
- Trainings provided on operation and maintenance of water facilities provided to water supply operators.
- Water and Sanitation Committees and maintenance groups established
- Awareness raised on promoting hygiene for local population in the project sites.
