

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1. INTRODUCTION

The proposed Turga Pumped Storage Project is located in the south-western fringe of Ajodhya plateau near Baghmundi village in the Purulia District, West Bengal. The proposed project envisages construction of a Rockfill dam across Turga Nala at higher reaches, a concrete gravity dam and a Rockfill dam across a saddle at lower reaches, an underground powerhouse in between the two reservoirs to generate 100MW peaking power.

The project was initiated with the officials of WAPCOS site office and the JICA survey team on 12th November 2017, for Ecological field survey for Asian elephant. The assessment of elephant's migratory path could be done by finding field signs (elephant droppings, mud stains on trees, footprints, food marks etc.).

It consists of two studies, Ecological field survey and Interviews survey for elephants.

3.1 Ecological field survey for Asian elephant (Elephants maximus)

Study on Legislative and Regulatory Considerations

• Survey Area:

The survey area is surrounding area of the upper reservoir planned site, mainly along streams in the forest/scrub area.

• Survey method and expected outcome:

Line censuses along streams are conducted along streams in the forest/scrub area to clarify seasonal migration pattern by finding field signs (elephant droppings, mud stains on trees, footprints, food marks, dead bodies, etc.).

5. METHDOLOGY ADOPTED

The elephant survey studies were carried out from 11th November 2017 to 23rd November 2017. The complete task was completed in two phase- Field Survey; Interview Survey; which are explained in detail below:

5.1 ECOLOGICAL FIELD SURVEY

The field survey was conducted in the survey area from 12th November, 2017 through 20th November, 2017 by the team of experts of JICA assisted by WAPCOS team of Supervisor, Coordinator, Recorder, Plotter and Guide.

During ecological field survey for Asian elephant, WAPCOS's team in the guidance of forest rangers and presence of experts of JICA study team found and traced out the signs of Elephant movement by means of tracing elephant droppings, mud stains on trees, footprints, food marks etc. Based on the findings, the team collected information regarding seasonal migration pattern of Asian Elephants in the surroundings of the Upper reservoir area mainly along streams in the forest and scrub area of Turga Pumped Storage Project.

Based on the traced path, the team of experts from JICA deduced that the path is clear of the surface project components, and reservoir area and may not affect the migratory path in future.

The daily report for the said survey depicting the path and co-ordinates of points passed through are included in the report given in **Annexure A** along with photographs of the signs.

The consolidated map of Elephant's migratory path based on the daily input is presented below along with some photographs of the Elephants presence field signs:





FIG-3. CONSOLIDATED MAP OF ELEPHANT'S MIGRATORY PATH






FIG-12. CONSOLIDATED MAP OF LOCATION OF PARTICIPANTS

Excerpt:

During the meeting, the elephant's existence in the Turga Project site or its probability to enter the area during construction period was discussed with the District Forest Officer (DFO). According to DFO, the elephant does not reside in the Turga project site, they only travel from this path for the search of fodder and water bodies. During the harvesting period, they migrate for 2 to 3 months for fodder, and in dry season they migrate for the search of water bodies. According to DFO, in the first season there may be a probability of elephant entering the project site, for which adequate preventive measures could be taken. However, in event of elephant entering the project area, the elephant movement could be controlled by organized 'Hulla party'.

During the succeeding years, the elephants may not enter the project area that there are no active water bodies in the project site. Moreover, as per his opinion elephants or any wild animals get violent or restless only when they see people clicking photographs or in order to protect their calves. During construction, these incidents may rarely happen.

Also he informed that they are trying to increase elephant's habitat in other parts of the forest by constructing check dams to increase the water bodies, planting fodder so that the path of wild animals can be restricted.

On 24th November, 2017, the study team discussed the matter and concluded the study as per the section 6: Conclusion given below.

6. CONCLUSION

The definitive elephant survey studies were carried out from 11th November 2017 to 23rd November 2017 by the expert's team of JICA assisted by the tea of WAPCOS Ltd., in the project area to access the elephant movement and its impact of the project construction activities and the project thereafter, on such movements.

The following conclusions were derived by the expert team of JICA based on the study:

- 1. There is no habitat of the Elephants in and around the project area.
- 2. The Elephant movement was found in the project area which is very seasonal.








November-2017_Elephant's Droppings

As could be seen from the photographs, the elephant's droppings in the month of October-2017 were fresh while in the month of November-2017, it looks old. Thus, confirming that elephant's migration through this path is only seasonal.


3. The movement of Elephants lies outside the location of Project components thereof. The same could be derived from the migratory path ascertained in the Fig. 3 above. Therefore, the construction activities wouldn't affect the Elephant migration pattern.

Based on above, it could be clearly drawn that the Project doesn't affect the Elephants movement nor the movement will affect the construction of the Project. However, adequate preventive measures could be taken beforehand for successful timely completion of the Project.


1. PREAMBLE:

J-Power awarded the work of Environmental and Social Investigation studies to WAPCOS. Now, J-Power entrusted to WAPCOS to carryout field survey on Elephants in the Turga Pump Storage Project area. As per the schedule WAPCOS team started the field survey on elephants at site from today i.e. 12.11.17 with the JICA survey team for Turga Pumped Storage Project, 1000 MW under JICA Preparatory survey.

2. **PROJECT OBJECTIVE:**

The objective of the survey as per ToR, is to collect latest data and information regarding seasonal migration pattern of Asian Elephants and collect their information by finding field signs (elephant droppings, mud stains on trees, footprints, food marks etc.) in the surroundings of the Upper reservoir area mainly along streams in the forest and scrub area of Turga Pump Storage Project.

5. Topography & Climate:

The climate today i.e. 12.11.17 is pleasant and dry with less humidity. The temperature is about 27° C, weather is clear.

6. Field Survey on 12.11.17

A team comprising of WAPCOS and the JICA survey team started the survey, from the route which was followed as directed by a guide, i.e. a person from the surrounding village. The schedule is as follows:-

- 1. WAPCOS and the JICA survey team commenced its journey from PPSP guest house at 8 am and reached left abutment of the Upper Dam axis at 8:45am by vehicle.
- 2. Then the team started walking from left side of the upper dam axis and reached at the Turga nala near V-notch. Then the team adopted the path where some foot prints were noticed. During discussion, the guide informed us that elephants might have adopted

this path for drinking water. All the data have been recorded by GPS. Then the team reached the summit i.e. junction point around 10.30 am.

- 3. After reaching the summit, guide showed the survey team elephant's main track of migration. They informed the team, this track is also used by the villagers for their day to day activities. Thereafter the team began elephant's main track survey around 10:48am. On the way elephant's foot print, droppings and its traces on vegetation were noticed in a close proximity and the same have been recorded by means of GPS and photographs.
- 4. Elephant's main track survey was finished approximately around 1:36pm.




Plate-1: Migratory Path of Elephants Surveyed on 12.11.2017







6. Field Survey on 13.11.17

A team comprising of WAPCOS and the JICA survey team began the journey for survey from 8 am and finished at 12 noon from downstream of the Upper Dam axis towards the lower reservoir. The route was guided by a person from the surrounding village (guide). Detail schedule is as follows:-

- 1. Same as on 12/11/2017, survey team commenced its journey from PPSP guest house at 8 am and reached the left abutment of Upper Dam axis at 8:45am by vehicle.
- 2. The route was same as on 12/11/2017 till the Turga nala near V-notch. Today, the team approached another path as directed by the guide. While walking on this route, the survey team reached the point where the survey of 12/11/2017 was finished at 9:30am.

- 3. Then from this point, survey team began walking on the main route of elephant's migration as informed by the guide. Here again elephant's foot prints, droppings, its traces on vegetation, stone and its hair were found and the same have been recorded by the same means of GPS and photographs. 


Plate-1: Migratory Path of Elephants Surveyed on 13.11.2017







Plate-1: Migratory Path of Elephants Surveyed on 14.11.2017







Plate-1: Migratory Path of Elephants Surveyed on 16.11.2017











Plate-1: Migratory Path of Elephants Surveyed on 17.11.2017










Plate-1: Migratory Path of Elephants Surveyed on 18.11.2017











Plate-1: Today's Path for Elephant Survey i.e. on 20.11.2017

Elephant Survey Interview held on 22.11.2017

Lastly, after the meeting cum interview session, the team including WAPCOS, the JICA survey team, WBSEDCL and a Baghmundi Forest Range Official headed towards the villages surrounding the project area located in the Bagmundi forest range. In these villages, the team randomly selected the villagers who filled a questionnaire form and were interviewed regarding the elephant's act. Following a brief introductory welcome, Sh. Manoranjan Mondal, Dy. Chief Engineer & Project Manager gave a detailed explanation to the entire gatherings in the Forest Range Office for the purpose of elephant's survey interview.

Subsequently Ajodhya Forest Range Officials, Forest Protection Committee and the villagers filled a questionnaire form prepared by the interviewers is enclosed in **Annexure-II**. In the meeting, the interviewees informed the team that they beat drums, burst fire crackers, burn firelight from the fuel provided by the Forest Range Office, torchlight and via Hulla party drive out the elephants from their area. The meeting cum interview was finished approximately around 12:30pm.

Then after the meeting cum interview session, the team including WAPCOS, the JICA survey team and WBSEDCL headed towards the villages surrounding the project area located in the Ajodhya forest range. In these villages, the team randomly selected the villagers who filled a questionnaire form and were interviewed regarding the elephant's act.
