## **Project Management**

The month of November 2006 was mainly occupied by setting up the office at Dhaka and Narshingdi, placement of Upazila Coordinators, staff orientation and introductory visits made by project management to all Upazilas.

Project office and Dhaka office have been functioning well with necessary facilities. The project office successfully organized weekly staff meeting at the project office, Narshingdi. The project office also provided necessary logistics support to Upazila Coordinators to organize Upazila Project Implementation Committee (UPIC) meeting at upazila level. All Upazila Coordinators had been able to organize office space at respective government premises.

### **Staff Orientation**

As all Upazila Coordinators joined the project on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2006, a two days Orientation programme was organized at the project office. The contents of the orientation programme were JICA profile; Project Design Matrix (PDM); common understanding on role of Upazila Coordinators,



working strategy and project management; issues related to administration and logistics.

### **Project Staff Meeting**

During November 2006 several meetings with project staff were organized at the project office, Narshingdi and weekly staff meeting was introduced accordingly. The purpose of weekly



meeting was to develop common understanding among all level project staff on project related technical and administrative issues; facilitate office arrangement in each Upazila and having agreement on priority tasks to be completed.

# District Project Implementation Committee (DPIC) Meeting

One of the key activities of project output no.2 is to establish District Project Implementation Committee (DPIC). Accordingly with inputs from central level and local level especially Deputy



Commissioner (DC), Civil Surgeon (CS) and Deputy Director Family Planning (DD-FP) the District Project Implementation Committee (DPIC) was formed. And the First meeting of the DPIC was held on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2006 at the conference room, DC office, Narshingdi. The meeting was presided over by the DC, Narshingdi as the Convener of the DPIC and CS, DD-FP and AD - CC, Narshingdi among others were present in the meeting. Along with Health and FP officials district officers of Social Services, Women Affairs, Youth Development and Local Government departments were present as members. The main discussions in the meeting were: membership and TOR of the DPIC; membership and TOR of the Upazila Project Implementation Committee (UPIC); frequency of the DPIC and UPIC meeting during the project period etc. In addition, introduction of JICA SMPP team was done at the meeting.

# **Upazila Project Implementation Committee (UPIC) Meeting**

One of the key activities of the project is to establish Upazila Project Implementation Committee (UPIC) at upazila level. As part of functioning the UPIC, Upazila Coordinators, JICA provided technical assistance to respective Coordinator (UNO) and Member Secretary (MO-MCH) in organizing first UPIC meeting at upazila level. UH&FPO, UFPO including others from H & FP and representatives from education social services, women affairs and youth development are the members of the UPIC. Until December 2006 three UPIC meetings were organized in three upazilas: Shibpur, Raipura and Polash. Other upazilas were in the process to organize UPIC meeting at respective upazila.



### Planning Workshop, Narshingdi

The Planning Workshop on Safe Motherhood Promotion Project (SMPP) was organized on 2th December 2006 by the District Project Implementation Committee (DPIC) at the conference room, DC office, Narshingdi. The workshop was chaired by Mr. Kamal Uddin, DC & Convener, DPIC. Mr. Eiichiro CHO, Additional Resident Representative, JICA Bangladesh was present as the Guest of Honour. Dr. Jafar Ahmad Hakim Director, MCH services, DGFP was also present as the special guest. Dr Monsur Ali, Civil Surgeon and Afroza Begum, DDFP and other members of DPIC and UPIC including representatives from CARE Bangladesh attended the workshop.

The purpose of the workshop was to orientate key stakeholders on the project and revise and agree the activities mentioned in the Project Design Matrix (PDM). SMPP team was actively involved to facilitate technical session including group work. As the partner, representatives from CARE Bangladesh were present in the workshop and introduced with all participants having small briefing on their role in the project.

# Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) Meeting

The first Joint Coordination Committee (JCC) meeting was held on 20<sup>th</sup> December 2006 at the Conference room, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Room No. 108, Clinic Building No. 9) presided over by Joint Chief, Planning, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare as the Chairperson of the JCC. Deputy Chief (Health) and Sr. Assistant Chief (Planning wing; FW-4) assisted the chair to organize the meeting. The following topics were discussed:



- Brief presentation on the project
- Membership and TOR of the JCC
- Discussion on PDM especially outcomes of the Planning Workshop, Narshingdi and Plan of Operation
- Overseas midwifery training


