Technical Training for the B-ME (Bridge Maintenance Experts) (13-15th June)

Ministry of Public Works and Transport (MPWT) has just started the MPWT's technical training for the road bridge Inspection engineers who play vital roles in the future of Cambodia, by building "B-ME (Bridge Maintenance Expert) " as the experts in the field, by the assistance of this TCP. This technical training course contains 2 days lectures and 1 day on-site training.

TCP's bridge inspection experts learned "necessity of bridge inspection", "role-sharing between MPWT and DPWT", "tips for bridge inspection" and "how to record inspection results" using textbooks which were prepared by TCP's experts and MPWT official members as the Bridge Maintenance Manual. In the on-site training, TCP's experts will instruct how to use bridge inspection tools and how to record the inspection results by using Ipad.

The first lecture was conducted for selected 4 MPWT trainees. All 4 trainees were qualified as B-ME who passed the exam confirming their competence level.

The engineers qualified as B-ME by the training will take responsible to expand and disseminate bridge maintenance techniques in Cambodia. Moreover, they will train ministries' engineers with support of JICA technical cooperation in the next step.
