Training for the next bridge maintenance engineers (Oct. 17-19)

Training for engineers by the Bridge Maintenance Experts (B-ME) who were admitted in the examination in June have begun. This training consists of two days of lectures where participants learn about the necessity of inspection, the role distribution during inspection, inspection items, and the recording of inspection results followed by a day of field work using the iPad system and inspection tools on actual bridges. Many engineers participated in this training, and all were able to pass the exam after the lectures. During the field work, the admitted B-MEs were actively explaining inspection methods to other engineers while paying attention to safety, showing the training of the project to be successful.

The engineers who received training this time are expected to pass on the bridge maintenance skills to other engineers, leading to a sustainable and effective bridge maintenance system in Cambodia directed by the Ministry of Public Works and Transport (MPWT).
