Soil Conservation Trainings have been conducted in all 7 villages!

Now, it's the season of ridge making for next maize cultivation in the villages in the project area. To prevent soil erosion and keep soil moisture, ridge making along the contour line is very important. Soil conservation trainings have been conducted in all the 7 villages since last month. In the training, participants enjoyed learning how to make a contour marker ridge using a Line Level and an A-flame.

The arc line on the left picture shows an ideal line for the contour marker ridge which participants set during the training. As the picture shows, current ridges are completely against the contour line.
