COMPONENT: Improvement of Public Service Delivery

PROJECT: Comprehensive Capacity Development Program for Bangsamoro (CCDP-B)

Background:

On March 28, 2014, JICA President Dr. Akihiro Tanaka and MILF Chairman Al Haj Murad Ebrahim agreed and committed that the peace dividends should be realized swiftly and inclusively to create confidence and mutual trust among the stakeholders of the peace process through the implementation of Quick Impact Projects (QIP).

After a series of consultations, the project outline was approved with the Bangsamoro Transition Commission (BTC) Socio-Economic Office as the counterpart agency and is responsible in the overall coordination for QIP while the Bangsamoro Development Agency (BDA) as the implementing agency in cooperation with JICA Cotabato Project Office (CPO).

Under QIP, twenty (20) barangays will be provided with one of the following social infrastructures; a) multipurpose hall, b) renovation/expansion of school buildings/classrooms, or c) warehouses with solar driers.

ACTIVITIES:

- 1) Site selection and validation – Based on the selection criteria identified by the QIP Task Force, BTC and BDA nominated several sites within and outside the Bangsamoro core territories. Validation teams were dispatched in order to confirm the needs in the areas as well as to ensure the cooperation of the target sites.
- 2) Conduct of Social Preparation – To ensure the cooperation of the target communities, community assemblies were conducted in order to select the appropriate facility and site. People's Organization (PO) will be organized in order to operate and maintain the project, as necessary.
- 3) Construction of QIPs – Local contractors will be hired to construct the facilities from February to July 2015 and it will be turned-over to the PO or school administration after completion.
