ACTIVITY: Bangsamoro Development Agency (BDA) Transitional Development Plan COMPONENT: Development Plan for the Bangsamoro PROJECT: Comprehensive Capacity Development Program for Bangsamoro (CCDP-B)

BACKGROUND:

In October 2012, the Government of the Philippines (GPH) and Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) peace panels signed the "Framework Agreement on the Bangsamoro" (FAB). As stated in the FAB Transition and Implementation, development programs in Bangsamoro communities whenever necessary will be coordinated in conjunction with the MILF Bangsamoro Development Agency (BDA). BDA was instructed to spearhead the formulation of the Bangsamoro Development Plan (BDP) by the MILF Chairman.

The BDP shall serve as the Transition Commission's (TC) guide to action in addressing needs of the Bangsamoro and the stakeholders in the area during the transition period.

The BDP will have two phases. Phase I is envisioned to focus on crafting the Development Plan for Transition Period (DPTP) that mainly deals with quick impact projects during the Bangsamoro Government Transition Period from 2015-2016. It was pointed out that most of the activities to be included in Phase 1 will be existing government (i.e., Sajahatra) and donor programs and projects. The DPTP shall contain concise and implementable sector-based plans that will lead to Phase II which is the development of a more comprehensive plan by year 2016. Phase II will be focused on crafting "medium/strategic interventions and investment (2016-2020) plans" of the Bangsamoro government.
