ACTIVITY: New Geographic Information System for Bangsamoro Areas (GIS) COMPONENT: Development Plan for the Bangsamoro PROJECT: Comprehensive Capacity Development Program for Bangsamoro (CCDP-B)

Background:

BDA was created by the MILF Central Committee in 2002 in pursuance of the rehabilitation humanitarian, and development aspects of the GPH-MILF Tripoli Agreement. Today, BDA plays a significant role in the transition period, during which intensified efforts for rehabilitation. reconstruction and development are being implemented to address the needs of Bangsamoro communities. In 2012, the Government of the Philippines and MILF signed the Agreement Framework the on Bangsamoro for the creation of a Transition Commission that will pave the way for establishment of the envisioned Bangsamoro Region. Following this momentous event, the MILF Chairman instructed the BDA to spearhead the formulation of the Bangsamoro Development Plan (BDP) which shall serve as a short term (Phase 1: 2014-2016) and medium/long term (Phase 2: 2016-2022) vision and strategy for the recovery and development of the Bangsamoro Area.

To support the BDA in the formulation of the BDP, JICA hired a GIS Consultant team to build a new GIS database for the Bangsamoro Area. The GIS is intended to serve as a foundation for making realistic and implementable plans by providing geographically-referenced information to the BDA. An upgraded GIS database for the BDA shall lead to more realistic planning and decision-making for the envisioned Bangsamoro Region.
