

Rice Field Day in Gezira State

Rice Field Day at Wad Al Naim demonstration field, Gezira State, was held on 6th November 2013. Approximately 300 people participated in this event.

Prof. Elzubair Bashir Taha, Governor of Gezira State, proposed the expansion of rice cultivation to 1,000 farmers in 30,000 feddans within 2 years. The state will prepare 100,000 SDG for establishment of an agricultural cooperative association and 20,000 SDG for extension officers. The state also has a plan to set up Regional Rice Technology Center. Eighteen media (3 TV, 4 radio, 11 newspaper) came to report this event.

The venue of this season's Rice Field Day was Wad Al Naim demonstration field, 4 feddans.

2. Winnowing




3. Milling




4. Packaging & Storing

This is the 2nd season of cultivation of rice for Mr. Bakri Alameen, farmer of Wad Al Naim field. He obtained more than 3360 kg/ha last season 2012. After sowing on 24th June, he implemented proper management in keeping with the important technical points on upland rice cultivation such as land preparation, weeding, irrigation and fertilization with Mr. Mohamed Alsamani, Extension officer. He is a reliable farmer. Mr. Bakri said that very tough job is weeding but good yield is promised if we do weeding properly. He thanks to Mr. Mohamed Alsamani to work with him closely.
