The Project provided opportunities of trainings abroad for total **305** extensionists/ administrators/researchers of MoA since 2010. The result is shown in a table right-hand side.

In the year 2014, the Project prepared 5 training courses in Uganda and Egypt (Advanced Training for Rice Cultivation in Uganda, Observation Type of Training on Rice Cultivation in Egypt, Training for Irrigation & Water Management in Egypt, Training for Weed Control in Egypt, Training for Rice Post-Harvest & Processing in Egypt). Total 71 extensionists/staff were trained. In addition, the Project (will) sends 10 extensionists/staff for 9 training courses in Japan.

The objective is to higher the ability. in terms of ways of seeding, fertilizer application, gauging yield component and judging optimum harvest time. The Project sent 15 extensionists to the training.

PRiDe Project accepts trainees from other African countries. The collaboration with PRiDe Project began in 2010. Total 138 Sudanese participants were trained so far in Uganda.

Training for Rice Post-Harvest & Processing in Egypt

The Project in collaboration with RTTC, conducted a Training for Rice Post-Harvest & Processing in Egypt (1 - 15 September, 2014). The objective is to understand and operate actual works about a whole range of post-harvest techniques such as the reduction of harvest loss, the installation and operation of RMU, the quality control of milled rice, appropriate rice packaging for sale and a proper method for rice storage. The Project sent 12 extensionists/agricultural engineers to the training.
