### 6.3 Bugando Medical Centre

#### Introduction

Bugando Medical Centre (BMC) is a referral hospital for the Lake Zone area. The hospital serves seven regions namely; Mwanza, Kagera, Mara, Geita, Shinyaga, Tabora, Simiyu and Kigoma. The hospital has 900 beds and over 1000 employees. BMC is also a teaching hospital with a University and a number of paramedical schools, which forms a Bugando College of Health Sciences (BUCHS). The paramedical schools are-Assistant Medical Officers Training, Pharmaceutical Technician Training, Radiographic Technician Training, Laboratory Technician Training and Nursing Officer General Training.

This hospital is owned by Tanzania Episcopal conference (TEC). Its recurrent cost is being met by the Government following an agreement between the Ministry of Health and TEC.

### 6.5 Muhimbili Orthopaedic Institute (MOI)

#### Introduction

The Muhimbili Orthopaedic Institute (MOI) is an autonomous institution established under Act No. 7 of 1996 with the main objective of providing primary, secondary and tertiary care for preventive and curative health services in the field of Orthopaedics, Traumatology and Neurosurgery, as well as being a role model for efficient hospital management gearing at self-sustainability.

MOI also provides teaching services for undergraduate, postgraduate and allied Health Science students for the Muhimbili University College of Health Sciences (MUCHS). A postgraduate course in Trauma or Orthopaedics is well established since 2001. MOI's long-term goal is to become a designated academic institution and training centre for the East, Central and Southern African region under the auspices of the East African Community (EAC) and the Southern African Development Cooperation (SADC). The institute has bed capacity of 150(Private 30 and Public 120) and the average number of patients is 166 per day.

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#### 6.6 Ocean Road Cancer Institute

#### Introduction

The Ocean Road Cancer Institute (ORCI) was established by Act of Parliament No. 2 of 1996. The Institute is the only specialized centre for cancer treatment in the country and is located along Ocean Road in Dar es Salaam. The Institute operates under the Ministry of Health and has its own Board of Trustee. Financing of the operations is through government subvention. Cancer treatment is offered free to the patient and therefore the Institute does not have the ability to generate extra funds through cost sharing to bridge financing gaps.

The Centre's bed capacity is 160. Ownership of the current premises is vested in the Institute. It has a common seal and own management answerable to the Board of Trustee. The services offered by the Institute are therapeutic, diagnostic, preventive, research and teaching.

### The Purpose of the Institute

- To control and manage the Institute and to assume responsibility for the control and management
  of such hospital or health facilities as may be vested in the Institute by order published in the
  official gazette.
- To provide medical care to inpatients and outpatients affected with cancer and other diseases in accordance with medical ethics
- To stimulate and promote programmes of education on health and particularly on cancer
- To conduct training programmes
- To provide consultant services
- To perform research activities with or without association with persons or institutions inside or outside the Republic
- To do any act for the purpose of achieving any of the above stated aims and functions of the Institute.

The proposed staffing level is based on the approved organogram of the Institute, bed capacity as well as the overall objective of the Institute which is quality health care provision to the clients.
