EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The MA program in Global Leadership at Vietnam Japan University (VJU) is aimed to foster global leadership qualities and competencies, in particular:

- Gain general knowledge and understanding of global leadership;
- Develop critical insights of global leadership through interdisciplinary approach of politics and security, economics, cultural and social issues as well as international relations;
- Develop important skills to work in the world of globalization and intercultural dialogues.

After graduation, students will have the competencies and skills required for leaders and managers, consultants, policy analyst, strategic advisors in regional and international organizations, central and local level national agencies, and international NGOs. They will also be able to pursue Ph.D in Global Studies, Political Science and Leadership.
