

New JICA will conduct the following cooperation schemes

Technical Cooperation Projects

JICA conducts technical cooperation projects through dispatching experts to developing countries to provide technical guidance, receiving trainees from these countries to Japan for technical knowledge and skill training.

ODA Loans

Those long term yen Loans with preferential and low interest rates are extended to developing countries for the purpose of promoting socio - economic infrastructure and stabilizing the economy of these countries.

Grant Aid

JICA provides necessary funding for fields of education, health care, transport ... in developing countries .

Sending volunteers

JICA sends Japanese volunteers to developing countries who have high voluntary spirit and want to share their experience and knowledge for the national building and people in these countries in a service term within 2 years.

JICA Partnership Programme

This is a technical cooperation programme at grassroots level in which JICA collaborates with non-governmental organizations (NGO), local governments, universities and social welfare organizations... in Japan to utilize their technology and experience in assistance activities for developing countries.

Emergency Disaster Relief

JICA sends emergency relief teams and supplies when a major emergency occurs in a developing country. Depending on the loss and needs of the suffering country, JICA will carry out one or many of those mentioned above.

Training Programme for Young Leaders

The programme invites talented young people in their 20s and 30s from developing countries to Japan for a period of 18 days to participate in training courses to improve their knowledge and profession; thus, to actively and effectively contribute to the development of their countries.

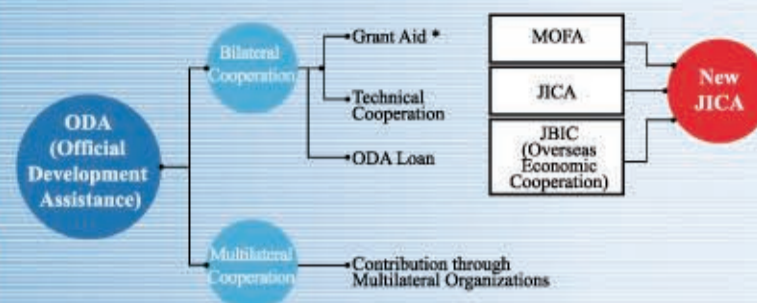

New JICA

ODA activities of Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and Japan Bank for International Cooperation (JBIC) have been merged from October 2008. Since new JICA is now able to extend three schemes of Japanese ODA: Technical Assistance, ODA Loans and part of the Grant Aid, new JICA can provide comprehensive assistance that most effectively addresses the needs of development countries from large scaled infrastructure construction to technical cooperation at grass-root level.

Therefore, new JICA can bring into full play the following principles in cooperation activities to improve its activities in the developing countries and to implement comprehensively international cooperation at high quality.

- 1 Speed-up: Speeding up cooperation
- 2 Scale-up: Scaling up cooperation
- 3 Spread-out: Spreading out results of cooperation



Note: This excludes Grant Aid which the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) will continue to directly implement for the necessity of diplomatic policy.

Basic Principle and Prioritized Areas for Vietnam
