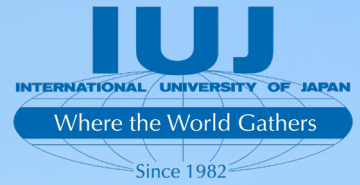

JICA Development Studies Program (JICA-DSP)

Various universities, in collaboration with JICA, have established JICA-DSP among the graduate school degree courses they offer. JICA-DSP consists of class subjects pertaining to the development experience of modern Japan (including the experience of Japan's own development and of its cooperation with other countries through ODA). This program offers JICA scholars a chance to deepen their understanding of Japan's development experience in the respective academic fields.



Japan-Global Development program (JGDP)

Japan-Global Development program (JGDP) is a two-year master's program offered jointly by the GSIR and GSIM to provide students the opportunity to learn universal development and growth logic in the fields of politics, economy, and management, using Japan's experiences in economic development and corporate growth as basic case materials. International students study the successes and failures in Japanese development experiences and acquire the knowledge and skills to consider development strategies for their homelands. Japanese students develop the ability to communicate Japan's development experiences to the world in English.
