## 1. Activity Report 2023

We wish you a Happy and Peaceful New Year, 2024.

As the COVID-19 pandemic has finally diminished after almost 3- year rampage, JICA revitalized its activities here in Papua New Guinea.

As of January 2024, we are proud of the projects ongoing in cooperation with PNG counterparts as follows: 2 Loan Projects, 10 Technical Cooperation Projects, 3 individual Expert Projects, 2 Private Sector Cooperation Surveys, and 5 JICA Volunteers. And 32 Long term trainees are currently studying at universities in Japan. In addition, 1 Cultural Grant Aid Project is under preparation.

In the following, we review main progress and achievements of 2023.

### (1) Nadzab Tomodachi International Airport opened



The opening ceremony of Nadzab Tomodachi International Airport was held on 2 October 2023 (Photo 2). This airport was constructed under the support of ODA Loan. Although the project faced difficulties such as COVID-19 pandemic and the following price escalation, we could successfully complete the construction with the tremendous efforts made by all of actors both in PNG and Japan. Many guests including Hon. Marape, Prime Minister and Ministers of PNG have attended the ceremony. Hon. Marape stated that this airport is a symbol of friendship between PNG and Japan. In fact, *Tomodachi* means friendship in Japanese, and the airport was named with the idea of Hon. Marape.



Through this project, the safety and effectiveness of the airport were improved, and the carrying capacity of the airport, as the 2<sup>nd</sup> international

airport in the country, is expected to be doubled.

### (2) Japan Overseas Cooperation Volunteers re-started

Although dispatch of Japan Overseas Cooperation Volunteers (JOCVs) had been suspended in March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the program has restarted with 3 new volunteers (Photo 3) in August 2023. These 3 volunteers are currently working as primary school or high school teachers at Sogeri town, Central Province.

JOCV program in PNG had started in 1980. And these 3

volunteers commemorated the total number of 800 volunteers dispatched to PNG. In PNG, there are 5 volunteers as of today and there will be another 3 by the end of March.



#### (3) Cooperation in education sector

The "Project for Strengthening Primary Teacher Preservice Education in Mathematics and Science" aims at improvement of mathematics and science capacity of primary school children in PNG. In this Project, materials for prospective math and science teachers are developed, so that the capacity of schoolteachers is to be improved using these materials. In the former project carried out from 2016 to 2019, the first national standardized textbooks of math and science were developed for G3 to G6. At present, workbooks are also being developed in

line with these textbooks in collaboration with Gakko Tosho Co. Ltd. Furthermore, JOCVs have also been involved in to maximize the impact of these activities (Photo 4).



# (4) Improvement of operation and maintenance of infrastructure

JICA supports to improve the capacity of public officers to operate, manage and maintain infrastructure of power supply, roads, and ports in PNG. In the "Project for the Improvement of Planning and Operation of Power System", JICA supports PNG Power Ltd. (PPL) to improve its capacity of planning, and operation and maintenance of substations and transmission lines for stable and trustful power supply. The equipment for O&M of transmission lines was supplied to PPL in November 2023.

### (5) Cooperation in health

JICA works with the Department of Health in the "Project for Elimination of Lymphatic Filariasis Phase 2"

in which 7 provinces are targeted to eliminate lymphatic filariasis. In 2023, the first Mass Drug Administration (MDA) was carried out in West New Britain Province (Photo 5).



#### (6) Protection of the environment

With JICA's support in solid waste management (SWM) in the past, development of SWM plan in National Capital

District and improvement of Baruni landfill site etc. were conducted in PNG. For further promotion of SWM, the "Project for Promotion of Regional Initiative on Solid Waste Management in Pacific



Island Countries Phase 3" has started in July 2023. In this Phase, the achievement of NCD will be disseminated to other cities of PNG such as Lae, and material recovery is also to be promoted. Besides, a student tour was conducted in October 2023, in which high school students visited Baruni landfill site and Port Moresby wastewater treatment plant to learn the importance of environmental protection (Photo 6).

In the field of forest protection, JICA supports PNG

Forest Authority to prevent degradation of forests through improvement of monitoring system of commercial logging. In 2023, JICA supported PNGFA to train its officials to practice Logging Code of Practice (LCOP),



and Planning, Monitoring and Control Procedure (PMCP) (Photo 7).

#### (7) Presentation of long-term trainees

Long term trainees who acquired degrees (mainly Masters) made presentations of their theses: 7 trainees

in July and 6 trainees in November 2023. The themes of



their studies vary from diplomacy and economy of PNG, sustainable forest management, nutrition status of children in COVID-19 pandemic, migrant policy of PNG and so on (Photo 8).

#### (8) JICA Chair

The JICA Chair, in which Japan's modernization is learned, was conducted. In May 2023, Prof. Kato Hiroshi, Vice President of International University of Japan visited UPNG for his lecture. In this lecture, students and lecturers from other universities in Lae and Goroka also attended on-line.

#### (9) Mr. Tanaka, JICA President, visited PNG

April 2023, Mr. Tanaka, President of JICA, visited PNG. He had meetings with Hon. Marape, PM, Hon. Rosso, DPM and Hon. Stuckey, Minister for Treasury (then), and

visited JICA project sites. He also visited UPNG where JICA Chair was organized and had a discussion with students about the modernization of Japan and development of PNG (Photo 9).



## (10) Activities in gender mainstreaming

JICA PNG Office has been promoting gender mainstreaming. As part of its activities, a seminar to prevent sexual harassment was held for JICA relating personnel, and introduction of females in FB, who are enthusiastically working in PNG society, and an event to promote gender mainstreaming with NDCD were conducted.

## (11) Our New Year resolution, 2024

Japan's ODA in PNG started in 1974 and this year commemorates the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

We hope to continue our efforts with our friends in PNG for further development of the country, deepening relationship between PNG and Japan, and contribution to the prosperity of the Pacific region.

It is very important that the children were able to solve the problem by themselves actually doing such activities. The classroom was filled with joy and satisfaction when they came up with the formula: "Area of a parallelogram = base x height."

I started working at Sogeri Primary School in September 2023. My main activity is to support the teachers for cultural exchange of students between Japan and Sogeri online, environmental education, and math education, etc. People in PNG are

pure and friendly. They wave me with smile when they see me on streets. I hope to bridge between the two countries. On my holidays, I sometimes enjoy diving at a beautiful sea in PNG!

#### Mr. SUZUKI Kento (Vegetable Growing)
