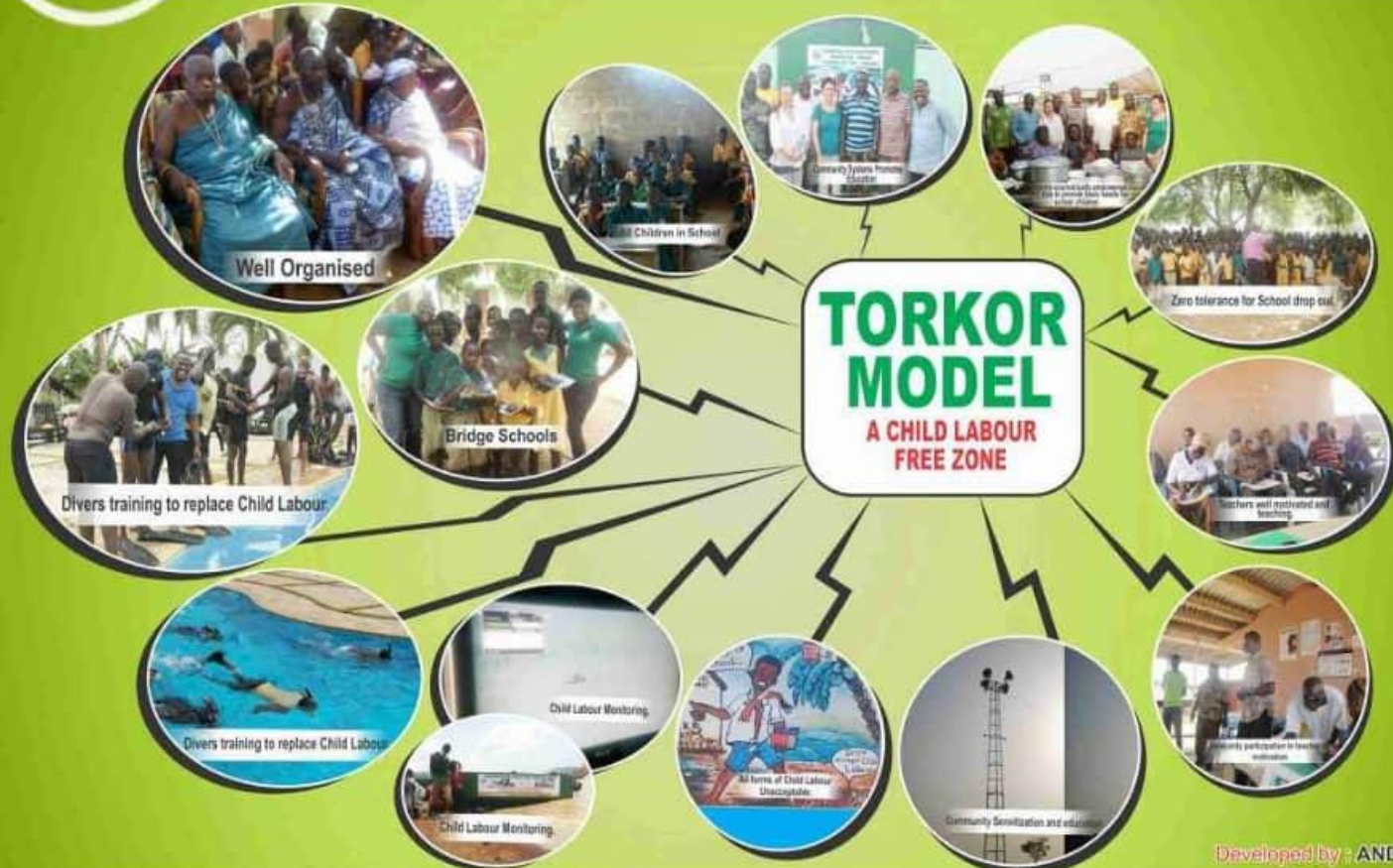

CHILD LABOUR FREE ZONES are (geographical) areas where all children engage in child labour are systematically withdrawn from work and (re)integrated into formal, full-time schools and those at risk prevented from engaging in such activities. No distinction is made between different forms of child labour because every child has the right to be protected from harmful work and given the opportunity to access education.

THE PROCESS OF CREATING CHILD LABOUR FREE ZONES involves all stakeholders like teachers, parents, children, unions, community groups, local authorities and employers in the end all stakeholders are convinced that child labour is unacceptable and work together to ensure that all children go to school.
