**Subject : Amendment of ECC
(ECC-CO-1708-0017)**

Dear Sec. Tugade:

This refers to the application for the amendment of Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC CO 1708-0017) issued to Department of Transportation (DOTr) for the **Metro Manila Subway Project (MMSP) Phase 1** to be located in Metro Manila on 25 October 2017.

After satisfying the requirements in the said application and upon recommendation of the Environmental Impact Assessment Review Committee, the Department through the Environmental Management Bureau (EMB), has decided to issue the ECC amendment for the above-mentioned project.

As such, ECC-CO-1708-0017 coverage is now amended as follows:

Original Coverage	Amended:
Construction and Operation of Metro Manila Subway Project comprising thirteen (13) underground stations and depot for trains in Brgy. Ugong Valenzuela Depot.	Construction and Operation of Metro Manila Subway Project comprising the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sixteen (16) subway stations including construction yards and shield machine bases;• Underground sections in-between the stations;• Valenzuela Depot;• Interoperability area between FTI Station and Bicutan PNR Station, and• Interconnections such as walkways and public utility vehicle (PUV) bays.

Likewise, the following conditions shall form part of this amended ECC:

- The modified alignment and construction of additional stations and facilities shall strictly conform with the modified design (technical and structural) submitted for purposes of amending the ECC; and
- The areas designated for relocation of affected settlers shall be made available to include fair and just compensation of damages/disturbances as determined by the concerned authorities prior to project construction.

All commitments, mitigating measures and monitoring requirements, contained in the approved Environmental Performance Report and Management Plan (EPRMP) particularly in the Environmental Management and Monitoring Plan (EMMoP) shall be instituted to minimize any adverse impact of the project to the environment throughout its

implementation. Further, all other conditions stated in the ECC-CO-1708-0017 shall be complied with and shall remain in force unless amended/revoked in writing.
