




CARD: Coalition for African Rice Development


- Established in 2008 at TICAD IV by NEPAD, AGRA and JICA

- A <u>consultative group</u> of bilateral and multilateral donors and African and international organizations/institutions



 - Has 23 member countries





PRODUCTION AND CONSUMPTION OF RICE (milled) AFRICA, (1960 – 2014)






- Widening demand-supply gap
