

PROJECT FOR HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT IN THE LEGAL SECTOR

Project period: July 2010 – July 2014

Project site: Vientiane (Ministry of Justice, Office of Supreme People's Prosecutor, People's Supreme Court and National University of Laos)

The Lao government has a master plan of building the country to be a state governed by the rule of law. To support the plan, this project is conducted by four organizations with approximately sixty counterpart personnel involved. The goal of the project is to let institutions and officials/lecturers in the legal and justice sectors and legal education, develop their institution/individual capacity to advance legal studies on Lao Law on the basis of systematized analysis of theories and practices. The main expected outputs are:

1. The Working Group composed of officials/lecturers of the MoJ, PSC, OSPP and NUOL is well managed.
2. The Working Group systematically analyzes legal theories and practical issues on Civil Code, Civil Procedure and Criminal Procedure, and develops a Model Handbook summarizing the result of the analysis.
3. The Working Group disseminates how to utilize the Model Handbook and its contents to institutions and officials/lecturers in the legal and justice sector and legal education.
