Practical training has commenced!!

☆ **Chuma village**



The first technical training in this village was "Fish farming". It was conducted on 21st and 22nd April. 17 Villagers including 6 women participated. The contents of the course were how to construct fish pond, followed by practical training on the same topic. The construction of fish pond will continue until the participants finish it. The size of the fish pond is about 6mX10m. The participants committed themselves and are struggling to dig the pond in a muddy field.

☆ **Zwanya village**



People's longing subject "irrigated vegetable growing" eventually took place on May 13 and 15 for theoretical part. Around 40 villagers with strong interests in participation made the repetition of this subject. After the repetition of theoretical training, practical part was conducted with enthusiastic participation of the people.
