Fundamentals for Growth

Located in the center of South East Asia, Vietnam needs to develop its social and economic infrastructure to maintain strong and sustainable growth, thus facilitating ASEAN's economic growth. JICA has cooperated to Vietnam's national transport and energy infrastructure, namely Noi Bai International Airport, National Road No.5 and Da Nim Hydro Power Plant, and capacity building for market economy and tax system management. JICA will continue to support Vietnam's economic growth through strengthening connectivity and supply chain in ASEAN by the North-South Highway, improving traffic and air pollution by HCMC metro line No.1, ensuring stable energy supply by developing smart power grids, and strengthening market economy institutions by introducing International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS).

Development of Transport Infrastructure

Development of fundamental infrastructure and urban traffic networks to improve connectivity in ASEAN, and support capacity building for smooth operation and maintenance of core infrastructure.

Accelerating Competitiveness

Human resources capable for innovation and social changes as well as key industries are essential for Vietnam's continuous and sustainable growth and development. JICA has cooperated to train some 100,000 Vietnamese through cooperation projects with educational institutions such as Vietnam Japan University (VJU), Vietnam-Japan Institute for Human Resource Development (VJCC) and Can Tho University. JICA will continue its supports in human resource development for advanced industries to enhance Vietnam's international competitiveness.

Human Resource Development

Capacity building to meet the increasing demands of the labor market and enhance advanced technology.



Value-added Agriculture

Establishing food value chains, improving productivity, and transforming agriculture structure to add value to agricultural produce of Vietnam through technology innovation.



No One Left Behind

Natural disasters, environmental issues, disparities between urban and rural areas, and lack of safety net for socially vulnerable caused by global climate changes and rapid economic growth endanger Vietnam's development. JICA has cooperated to build and upgrade central hospitals such as Bach Mai, Hue and Cho Ray, core research institutes; respond to floods and natural disasters; support human trafficking victims; build and upgrade sewerage systems; and train more than 100,000 personnel. JICA will continue to support Vietnam's comprehensive and integrated development through projects to ensure human safety (anti-pollution, climate change, inclusive finance, inclusive healthcare system and supports for elderly and disables).



Disaster Management, Climate Change
Mitigation and adaptation to climate changes by improving local people's awareness and building capacity for disaster prevention to municipalities especially in the central region.



Health Care, Social Security
Capacity building for rehabilitation, aged-care and infectious disease prevention, and development of health care system to achieve Universal Health Coverage.

Urban Environment Management
Development of environmental protection regulations and measures, sewerage systems to deal with environmental issues such as increasing wastes and water pollution.



Stability and Development

Executive functions which meet the requirements of rapid socio-economic development and globalization, legislative functions which include building and perfecting the legal system to deal with complex and advanced social and economic problems, and judicial functions of managing stable and uniformed law enforcement are the fundamentals of a country's development. JICA has cooperated improving and drafting legal documents especially the civil law in 1996, training administrative and legal officers, and strengthening the capacity of the national assembly. JICA will continue to support Vietnam's stability and development through trainings in the public sector to ensure the effective and efficient operation of the political and administrative apparatus, and cooperation in new areas such as e-government, cybersecurity and maritime security.



Strengthening legislative and judicial capacity

Strengthening the capacity of law enforcement officers and information security managers to ensure stable, consistent, secured law enforcement and information security.



Strengthening administration capacity

Administrative system improvement and capacity development for officers to enhance the good administration to meet the requirements of rapid socio-economic development.
