2	2(d)	14	Proposed roles and responsibilities	Given that the insurance partner is required to provide CCE data, how many years worth of CCE data do they have?	<p>The insurance partner possesses three years of historical yield data (CCE data), spanning the 2021–2022 to 2023–2024 planting seasons, specifically for the selected crops: wheat and barley.</p> <p>Once the DP is onboarded, it is expected that additional CCEs will be requested to supplement the existing dataset and ensure adequate data coverage for model development and training. These additional CCEs are planned for the 2024–2025 planting cycle.</p>
