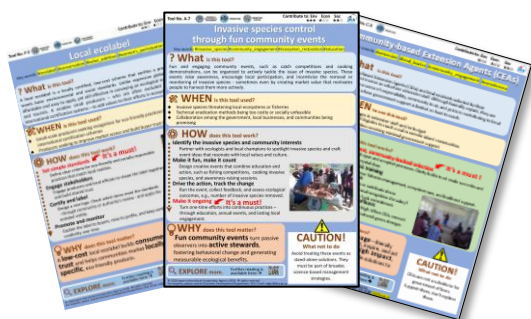

“Toolbox of Ideas” for Field Practitioners

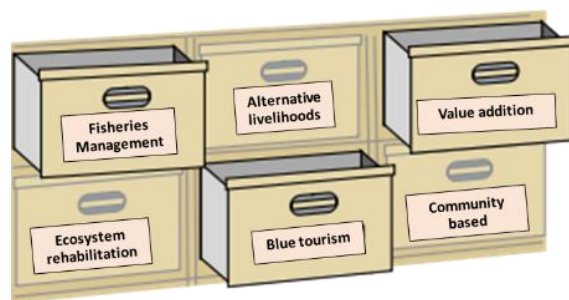
In promoting blue economy, multiple challenges intersect, and it is often difficult to know how and where to start.

The Toolbox contains two-page “Tool Sheets.” Each sheet explains what challenges it addresses, how to implement it, and why it works.

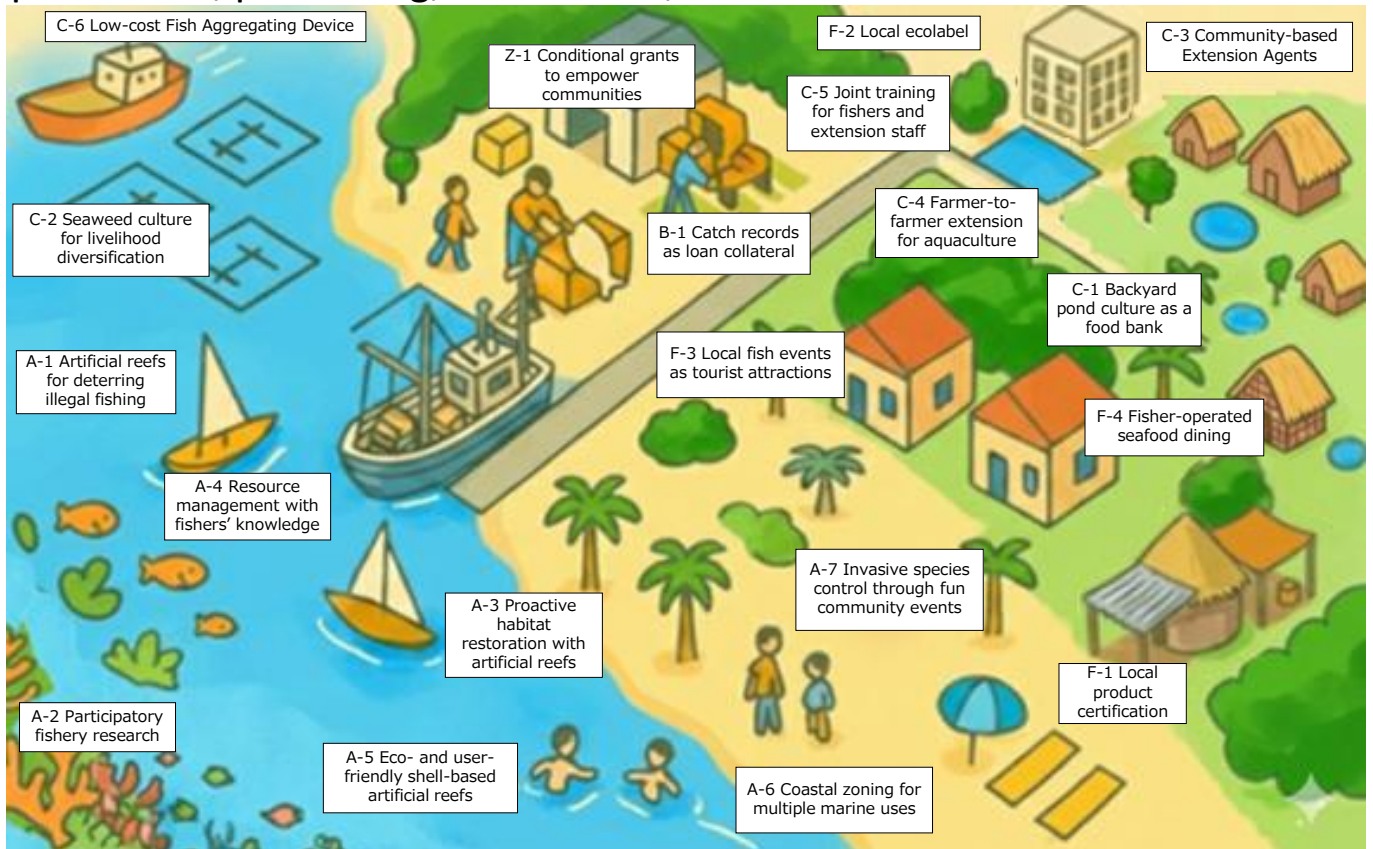
What Can We Do with the Toolbox?
