BACKGROUND

- Even with the rollout of the vaccination, COVID-19 (C19) continues to spread worldwide with many countries still experiencing multiple waves of infections. Therefore, the world is shifting from building a “post-C19” society, to a “with C19” society: a society that is able to live safely alongside the virus. One essential piece of this society is finding a way for public transportation, a key means of transportation for essential workers, to continue to run smoothly.
- Governments and public transport operators in each country are implementing various infection prevention and control measures to make public transport cover the 3S's (Safety, Security and Sanitation).
