


Story1 Sanitation





Adam meets his friend and they go to the Water Yard together.







At the Water Yard, they noticed that there are a lot of domestic animals near the Water Yard.












The next day in the morning, Adam goes to his friend's house to play football together, but he and his family suffer from stomach ache and Diarrhea.




So Adam can not play. On the way to go back to home, he also starts to feel stomach ache.







Adam's father says "according to their symptom,
this stomach ache might be due to water disease"





If there are lots livestock excreta, the bacteria and virus drops to under-ground water source and are contained into WY water. Therefore, they becomes a reason of stomach ache, diarrhea, and vomit. 
He also said there are also some bacteria, virus and small insects in hafeer water. For the water to be healthy from bacteria, virus and small insects, the water boiling is a good way. another way is to seperate the livestock from the people in the water yard.






After drinking the boiled water for several days, Adam later recovered.






After getting better Adam goes to WY to take water but there is no domestic animal near WY. then he notices a board.




-Do not take domestic animals to the side of water provision to people.

-If the livestock excreta are left near WY, diseases can transfer easily to people and the livestock.




-Do not take domestic animals near inside WY facility.

-If the livestock excreta are left near WY, diseases can transfer easily to people and the livestock.




In the evening time, Adam walks with his goat near WY. But he remembered the rules.





Adam says "the WY rules for all community residents to keep WY water clean, so I should follow them!"




Remember:

❖ Hafir water also contains bacteria, virus and small insects. Escape to use it for drinking water.


❖ to drink healthy water, the water must be taken from people side and boiled.




Story2 Fair Water Provision



Adam sees some strange persons (not community residents) on the way to WY. Their direction is to WY and Adam goes to WY together with them.








The persons and Adam arrive WY and introduce each other. They are from a neighboring community and Adam is surprised a little.





However he does not understand the reason why they come to WY to get water from other community.








Adam talked his father about the persons that Adammet today, and explains the neighboring community situation.




His father admits this situation. He explains that our water committee is supporting to repair their damaged WY and also is persuading the neighboring water committee to provide the water to all resident fairly.






Adam asks his father about the reason why our community equally provides water with all people, not only community residents but also outsiders of our community.







Our community people understand the importance of fair water provision to all people for good relations with neighboring communities.






After our WY accepted all people, neighboring community people have started to visit our community and exchange among communities is promoted.







After some days, Adam again meets the persons from neighboring community and consider that thanks to fair water provision, I can meet them at WY.






Adams father informs him that the neighboring community's WY is repaired and the community people set the rules for fair water provision.





Adam realizes that he can not meet the community person any more. However, he expects to visit the community and to meet them someday.





Remember:

He found his younger brother played with his boy friends at WY.









Adam sees that there are many people wait for WY. Due to some damage, water comes out only a little




Adam Also remembers that his younger brother and his friends played near WY and guess that they might break the taps.



Adam asked his brother about the yesterday's play at WY. His brother answered that when his friend stood on a valve, he broke it a little





However, at that time, the valve was not broken so much and small amount of water could come from the taps.











He continue to explain that WY is very important for our community so all residents should use it carefully. Therefore it is important not to play at WY.




Also if you see the damage of WY, you need to inform the damage to water committee members. If the damage is not serious, it is easy to repair.









After 1 week, Adam sees that the damaged valve is repaired




Story4 Tariff Payment






Adam waited for so long to get water. while he was waiting he noticed that there was a damage in the water tank tap













Adam saw a young girl paying tariff while some adults are not.





After Adam saw the girl leaving with her water he went to talk the adults into paying tariff but they would not listen to him.






Adam went to talk the neighboring adults into paying tariff. some of them agreed and went to pay.





but there are those who still would not listen to him. Adam was embarrassed.








After days, as Adam was waiting for water he saw his adult neighbors talking the other adults into paying tariff for the damages to be repaired.





The adults agreed and went to pay tariff. Adam was happy.






After a week, Adam's father told him that they have enough fee for the repairs and appreciated his efforts.





After days, the damages were repaired and the water volume increased.






The villagers kept on paying tarrif.
