1. The Government of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam has received a grant from the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) towards the cost of the Project above and intends to apply part of the grant towards payments under the Contract above.
2. The Purchaser above now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the procurement of Goods for Conservation and Restoration for Cultural Heritage.
3. Bidding will be conducted through procedures in accordance with the applicable Procurement Guidelines for the Japanese Grants, and is open to Bidders who meet the qualifications defined in the Bidding Document. However, the Bidder, or all members constituting the Bidder in the case of JV, shall be Japanese juridical persons controlled by Japanese physical persons. Any firms, who fall under any of the items of Article 26, paragraph 1 of the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act (Law No.228 of 1949, Japan), shall not be regarded as being controlled by Japanese physical persons. Other conditions for Eligible Bidder are as per the Bidding Document.
