The Integrated Energy and Power Master Plan Project

Project Status: Ongoing

Project Period: July 2021-December 2023

Type of Cooperation: Technical Cooperation

Goal of the Project: To establish a low/zero carbon energy demand/supply system, with energy security and economic viability, by introduction of policy and technologies for low carbon/carbon neutral society, towards sustainable development of Bangladesh.

The specific indicators will be as follows;

- To improve energy intensity (Annual consumption of primary energy/GDP PPP), as an indicator for energy conservation and efficiency.
- To improve CO2 intensity (CO2 emission / GDP PPP).

Project Outputs: An integrated master plan by focusing on establishing a low/zero carbon energy system in the long term perspective, which is necessary for achieving sustainable development of Bangladesh, will be formulated.

(An integrated master plan will consist of a several scenarios of 3E+S (Environment, Energy Security, Economic viability and Stability), with target years of master plan will be 2050, 2041, 2030, in consistent with the Paris Agreement and the country's "Vision 2041.")

Matarbari Ultra Super Critical Coal-Fired Power Project

Project Status: Ongoing

Project Period: June 2014– July 2024

Type of Cooperation: ODA Loan (437,754 million JPY as of now)

Goal of the Project: To alleviate shortage of power generation and improve stable power supply in Bangladesh by constructing 600MW x 2 units of Ultra Super Critical Coal-Fired Power Plant in Matarbari area in Maheshkhali upazila under Cox's Bazar district of Chattogram Division, thereby contributing to nationwide economic development and improvement of living standard.





Energy Efficiency and Conservation Promotion Financing project (Phase: 1& 2)

Project Status: Ongoing

Project Period: Sep 2016–Sep 2027

Type of Cooperation: ODA Loan (32,064 million JPY)

Goal of the Project: To promote Energy Efficiency and Conservation (hereafter referred to as “EE&C”) measures, and to facilitate installation of EE&C equipment in Bangladesh additionally to assist Government of Bangladesh (hereafter referred to as “GOB”)’s policy realization in Renewable Energy and EE&C promotion by extending concessional loans and other support for implementing the Project, thereby inducing the stability of the energy supply and demand and contributing to the mitigation of climate change.

Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport Expansion Project

Project Status: Ongoing

Project Period: July 2017-March 2024

Type of Cooperation: ODA Loan (156,825 million JPY as of now)

Goal of the Project: To meet future demand of air transportation and to improve airport capacity, convenience and safety, by constructing international passenger terminal 3, cargo terminal and other infrastructure facilities at the Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka, thereby contributing to further economic growth in Bangladesh.

Dhaka Mass Rapid Transit Development Project (MRT Line-6)

Project Status: Ongoing

Project Period: February 2014-December 2025

Type of Cooperation: ODA Loan (255,798 million JPY)

Goal of the Project: To alleviate traffic congestion in Dhaka to provide a smooth flow of people and goods, and stimulate economic activity. The MRT Line-6 is expected to connect Uttara to Kamalapur with a total length of 21.5 kilometer. It will carry 4.2 million passenger-kilometer/day and shorten the average travel time by more than half (from 110 minutes to 36 minutes). The Project is also expected to reduce the emission of greenhouse gases (GHG) and help alleviate climate change.





Kanchpur, Meghna and Gumti 2nd Bridges Construction and Existing Bridges Rehabilitation Project

Project Status: Completed

Project Period: February 2014- January 2020

Type of Cooperation: ODA Loan (81,675 million JPY)

Goal of the Project: To strengthen the capacity and efficiency of transport and to improve the safety of bridges in Bangladesh by rehabilitating existing Kanchpur, Meghna and Gumti bridges, and constructing 2nd new Kanchpur, Meghna and Gumti bridges adjacent to their existing bridges on the Dhaka – Chattogram National Highway No. 1, thereby contributing to sustainable economic development of Bangladesh.

Jamuna Multipurpose Bridge Project

Project Status: Completed

Project Period: March 1994- June 1998

Type of Cooperation: ODA Loan
(123,697 million JPY as of now)

Goal of the Project: To establish a link between the east and west region of Bangladesh, to integrate the country by generating multifaceted benefits for the people, promoting better inter-regional trade and economic and social development. It enables quick movement of goods and passenger traffic by road and rail across the Jamuna River, along with facilitating transmission of electricity, transfer of natural gas and integration of telecommunication links.

Type of Cooperation: Technical Cooperation

Goal of the Project: To improve the municipal solid waste management including waste collection, transportation, operation of landfill sites, organizational and institutional systems. The project developed solid waste management master plans for Dhaka North City Corporation and Dhaka South City Corporation and conducting activities to achieve 'Zero Waste' by waste reduction and 3R (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle) concept. The success in Dhaka is also transferred to Chattogram City Corporation.



Karnaphuli Water Supply Project Phase 1-2

Type of Cooperation: ODA Loan (34,847 million JPY)

Goal of the Project: The completed (2017) and ongoing Karunaphuli Water Supply Project will add 286 million liter water per day (MLD) from the newly constructed water treatment plant through 33 km transmission pipe and 600+ distribution pipes to be replaced and newly connected service pipes. The project will enable 24/7 water supply with higher water pressure in Chattogram City.



Construction and Establishment of Meteorological Radar in Dhaka and Rangpur

Goal of the Project: New radar systems will be equipped with S-band Doppler radars, which can collect 3 dimensional meteorological data on atmospheric moisture, intensity of rain and wind velocity distribution much faster as well as in a more accurate manner than the previous radars. It is expected that, with these advanced technologies, precise weather forecast, and more accurate and earlier hazardous warnings will be made available to the public. 




Technical Cooperation Disbursements by Fiscal Year


