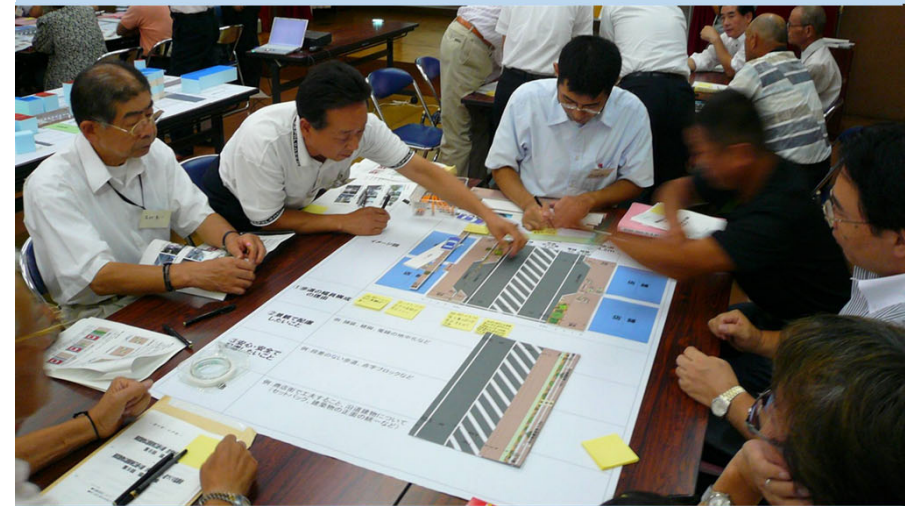

Offered to central and local governmental officials in charge of urban planning and urban development projects.

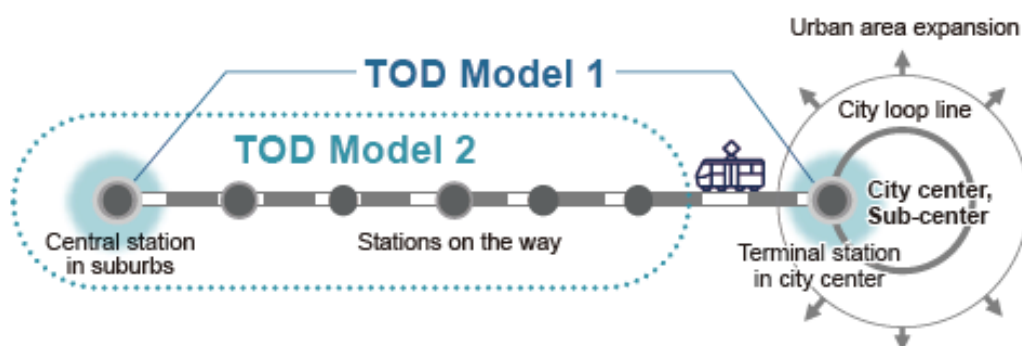

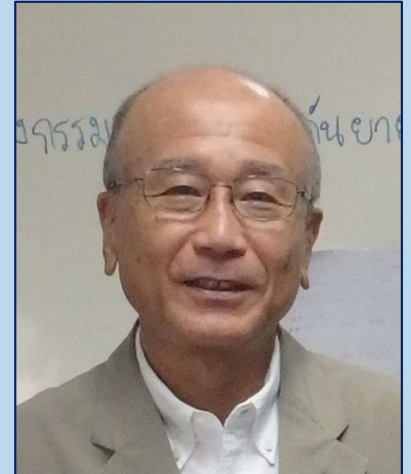
