## What is JICA Partnership Program (JPP)?

The JICA Partnership Program (JPP) is a technical cooperation program implemented by JICA to contribute to the social and economic development of developing countries at the grassroots level in collaboration with its partners in Japan such as NGOs, universities, local governments, and corporations.

The program was introduced in 2002 to support the implementation of projects formulated by the Japanese partners to utilize their accumulated knowledge and experience in assistance activities for developing countries.

### 3 types of JPP

#### Partner Type

Qualification: Japanese NGOs, universities, and corporations with ideally 2 or more years of experience in international cooperation.

##### Budget

Up to 100 million yen

##### Selection

1-2 times/year

##### Implementation Period

Up to 3 years

#### Support Type

Qualification: Japanese NGOs, universities, and corporations active domestically or internationally for 2 or more years yet without much experience in international cooperation.

##### Budget

Up to 10 million yen

##### Selection

1-2 times/year

##### Implementation Period

Up to 3 years

#### Community Proposal Type

Qualification: Local governments ("The project activities may be implemented by the local organizations such as NGOs recommended by the local governments.")

##### Budget

Up to 60 million yen

##### Selection

1-2 times/year

##### Implementation Period

Up to 3 years

76 projects (36 Partner-type, 12 Support-type, and 28 Community-Proposal-type projects) have been implemented in Cambodia under the JPP scheme since 2002.

## Case 1

### Partner Type



The project "Physical Education for All" in Cambodia (Learning Quality Physical Education from Primary School) to Upper Secondary School

#### Heart of Gold

##### Project Goal

New style of PE following the contents of curriculum and Teachers' Manual is diffused at Primary schools, Lower Secondary Schools and Upper Secondary Schools in target 3 city and provinces under the control of MoEYS, POE and DOE of each city and province.

**Background:** Since 2006, Hearts of Gold has been conducting the projects such as developing and diffusing PE curriculums and teachers' manuals of Primary and Lower Secondary Schools, developing PE curriculums of Upper Secondary Schools, and developing National Institute of Physical Education and Sport as the 4-year physical education teacher training institute from its 2-year system; however, for further integral diffusion of PE, it is required to establish the model system of conducting consistent PE.

**Activities:** · Developing and implementing PE Diffusion Plan cooperating among POE and DOE in 3 target city and provinces  
· Developing human resources who can develop and diffuse the new style of PE with its Diffusion Plan  
· Developing a PE diffusion contents, monitoring of its usage and revising it with the suitable situation

## Case 2

### Support Type



Model Formulation of Dry-Period Farming by Utilizing Irrigation Ponds and Implementation of Demonstration Program in the Rural Area by Royal University of Agriculture in Cambodia

Kindai University/Japan  
Royal University of Agriculture (RUA)/Cambodia

##### Project Goal

Formulate a dry-season farming model that utilizes irrigation ponds and implement the model in the agricultural activities at local high schools.

**Background:** [Local farmers] The irrigation systems damaged due to civil wars and floods are left unutilized. / The low agricultural productivity due to the lack of water during the dry season and irrigation techniques forces farmers to turn to non-agricultural labors. [RUA] The system to collaborate with local farmers to disseminate RUA's knowledge and techniques has not been effectively developed.

**Activities:**  
· Formulate a dry-season farming model at RUA.  
· Implement the model in the agricultural activities at 3 high schools in 3 provinces.
