Results attained

Institutional level	It strengthened coordination among related, intersectoral and information institutions. It strengthened the employment of people with disabilities. It strengthened rehabilitation services for people with disabilities in the region.
Implementation of strategies	Promote the activities of the strategy the Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR). Empowering people with disabilities.
Experts	The project included three long-term experts, and 18 other short-term experts in the areas of rehabilitation and inclusion.
Japan training	22 people traveled to Japan to receive training and other 30 people were trained third country.

Donated equipment	Rehabilitation equipment have been donated for a total of approximately \$ 86,293 U.S. dollars.
Training sessions	66 training sessions were conducted in several areas, for a total of more than 5000 people trained in Costa Rica. 26 disabled people were trained as facilitators, making 1388 train other people.
Manuals	6 types of manuals, preparation 4 with a preventive approach and 2 curative approach to improve rehabilitation.
