## JICA Development Studies Program (JICA-DSP)

Various universities, in collaboration with JICA, have established JICA-DSP among the graduate school degree courses they offer. JICA-DSP consists of class subjects pertaining to the development experience of modern Japan (including the experience of Japan's own development and of its cooperation with other countries through ODA). This program offers JICA scholars a chance to deepen their understanding of Japan's development experience in the respective academic fields.

The course offers students comprehensive study in the areas of politics, law, economics, social development, science, technology and innovation, and other areas of specialization. The aim of the development studies course is the cultivation of individuals who can serve as top leaders to engage in future national development in developing countries. Admitted students will enroll in any one area of study and will be able to learn about different aspects of Japan's development through "Lectures for Japan's Development Studies," which are offered by every Development Studies course.
