#### **Aiming to**


- Show development impact / outcome for priority issues towards contributing the SDGs and achieving JICA's medium and long-term targets.

### **JICA Global Agenda**

- JICA's cooperation strategies (20) for global issues set under the 5<sup>th</sup> Medium-term Plan (fiscal 2022-26).
- Stating cooperation <u>priorities</u>, <u>targets</u> and approaches towards contributing the SDGs

### **Cluster Strategy**

- A group of projects across countries, sharing common logic of socio-economic development process ("Development Scenario") under JICA Global Agenda.
- Setting targets and aiming to deliver <u>development</u> <u>impacts/outcomes as a "Cluster" beyond individual projects</u>

- Promote dialogue with partner governments (Request-based approach based on proposals and dialogue):
- Maximize development impact through "PLATFORM" to collaborate and cocreate with various partners (such as donors, NGO, private sector, academic institutes, local gov. etc)
- Enhance accountability by effectively showing the results of clusters, linked to the results of the Medium-Term Goals
- Visualize impact / outcomes through monitoring



#### 1. Objective

#### (1) Objective of Global Agenda

The growth of private enterprises or private sector development<sup>1</sup> is the engine of self-sustained economic growth, job creation and expansion, and higher national income. It is the foundation that supports the public finances or national revenues. Developing countries are faced with a range of challenges that often delay their economic growth. External environments which are beyond the control of private enterprises (i.e. industrial and investment policies and the business environment) need to be improved and basic knowledge, technologies, expertise, and human resources, all of which are the basis for business growth, need to be learned and developed. By addressing and providing support to overcome these challenges that require the public sector's intervention and by dealing with funding aps, JICA seeks to develop private enterprises in developing countries and improve their competitiveness, promote innovation, investment, and industries, and ensure sustainable and quality growth and development. JICA also aims to achieve economic resilience for both developing countries and Japan through enhanced collaboration and partnership between local and Japanese companies.

#### (2) Objective of Development Scenarios ("Clusters")

In order to achieve the above objective, JICA strives to deliver the following results in the Global Agenda. ((f) to (III) below are the clusters that JICA places a particular focus on for that purpose.)

- Development of competitive entrepreneurs and businesses. ((I) Africa Kaizen Initiative and (II) Support for entrepreneurs to create business innovation (NINJA))
- Improvement of external environments (i.e. industrial and investment policies and the business environment) and access to finance and markets, both of which are needed for private enterprises to grow. ((III) Promotion of investment and industries in Asia)
