The creator of the logo is Ms. Fumiko Yamane.

The Volunteers who are or had been dispatched in the fields of art, design, and clothing were invited to submit applications for the logo, and Ms. Yamane's work was selected through a vote within JICA.

【Creator's Introduction】

Having an experience in an advertising company as a designer, she became interested in the JICA volunteer, and worked as a short-term volunteer in Argentina in 2016 and Zambia in 2019 in the field of design. In 2020, she was also scheduled to work in Marshall for one year, but returned to Japan in less than three months due to the COVID-19.
