Since 2017, three curriculums have been put in place; a Medical Science Course, a Public Health Course (2 years) and a one-year Public Health Course. This strengthens and enriches our core program based on the practice of integrated education, while maintaining a framework of one specialty.

Features and Curriculu m of Program	 We offer three courses in the Master's Program to correspond to various social needs. 1)Medical Science Course This course aims to train highly specialized professionals who are capable of playing active roles with broad knowledge of medical and life science fields. 2)Public Health Course (two-year course) This course aims to foster human resources that are capable of addressing the challenges of public health with substantial knowledge and skills for maintaining and improving people's health, life and security as well as the entire society. 3)Public Health Course (one-year course) This course is intended for medical doctors (i.e. licensed physicians), dentists, pharmacist and other professionals with certain years of practical experience, and aims to train, in one year, a highly specialized professionals who plays active roles in medical and public health fields.
