### SPECIFIC CONDITIONS TO RELI ASSET HOLDING COMPANY FOR UNDERTAKING ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESMENT FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF FLOOD PROTECTION MEASURES FOR CENTRAL RAILWAY LINE FROM KILOSA TO GULWE (84KM) IN MOROGORO AND DODOMA REGIONS

#### ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN IMPLEMENTATION

1. Ensure that, the mitigation measures are implemented accordingly as stated in the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Study;
2. Ensure that a proper environmental management organization pertinent with the type of project, at both project and site level is developed and made operational to guide the implementation of the Environmental Management and Monitoring Plans for the project;
3. Engage an Environmental Expert to guide implementation of the Environmental Management and Monitoring Plans;
4. Maintain, liaison with the key regulatory institutions and sectors in the course of implementation and operation of the project and prompt reporting of incidents as per law;
5. Ensure all affected persons are compensated fair and prompt before project implementation,
6. Ensure Resettlement Action Plan is completed before project implementation,
7. Information on the mitigation measures that may arise due to changing weather patterns such as heavy rains and flash floods is missing, Ensure flood protection measures are in place throughout the project lifespan,
8. Ensure official comments and recommendations from Ministry of Water-for current plan of dams and catchment management, TANROADS- for harmonization of road design and the proposed railway line design, PMO-Disaster Management Department- for identification of disaster management coordination are obtained. Communicate the same to the Council before project implementation,
9. Ensure sustainability of the project by addressing floods and siltation challenges,
10. Ensure to have an Environmental Office to implement the EIA report,
11. Ensure that solid and liquid wastes are properly managed during all phases of the project;
12. Ensure that establishment of proper monitoring schedules for soil, water and air quality are made as indicated in the Environmental Monitoring Plan;
13. Ensure that the Government through its Mandated Institutions gets access to monitoring data, monitoring network facilities and are facilitated to verify any monitoring information;
14. Ensure that, one copy of the EIA report is submitted to Wami/Ruvu Basin Water Board, Ministry of Water and Irrigation, TANROADS, Prime Minister's Office- Disaster Management Department and another copy is submitted to Municipal Environmental Management Officers in Kilosa District Council and Mpwapwa District Council so as to facilitate the EMP implementation and follow-up.

#### A. SAFETY MATTERS

20. All commitments aiming at demonstrating the Company's observance of the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) principles should for key items be in form of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with relevant communities and all MoUs should be witnessed by relevant Local Government Authorities (LGAs);
21. Ensure that communities around the project area and general public are aware of the dangers they can be exposed to by the project activities; in its regard, a communication and awareness raising strategy to the local community and the general public should be put in place and implemented throughout the lifetime of the project;
22. Monitoring of the environmental quality should be extended to the nearby community areas and the project buffer zone, focusing on water quality, air quality and soil quality; monitoring results should among others, be periodically communicated to the Project Affected Persons (PAPs).

#### D. OTHER LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

23. Ensure that, legal requirements by other authorities to which the operations of this project have relevance are complied with. These include among others, Wami/ Ruvu Basin Water Board Office, Ministry of Water and Irrigation, Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock development. Prime Minister Office- Disaster Management Department and any other authority mandated to oversee the operations of the project;
24. Ensure to pay relevant legal fees/subscriptions to the Council in accordance with the Environmental Management (Fees and Charges) Regulations, 2008.
