Workshop for consultants and JICA staff Action, lessons learned, and recommendations for handwashing and hygiene awareness activities

On November 27, 2020, "workshop for consultants and JICA staff on water sector (33rd)" was held under the theme of "issues and lessons learned on handwashing and hygiene awareness". In this workshop, consultants*1,2 presented examples of hygiene awareness activities to promote handwashing (in Burkina Faso, Senegal, Mozambique, etc.), their actions and lessons learned on how to cause behavioral changes in hygiene awareness activities and make them take root as behavior.

- Positive deviance to ensure sustainability] Positive deviance, which is problem-solving through different and unusual actions and methods, is also effective as a way to increase the sustainability of activities. (Ex. burning locally available incense in the toilet to deodorize and scent the toilet, and installing a rainwater tank next to the toilet to use for toilet water, etc.).
- [Teach skills to local workers] Teaching new construction skills, such as installing tiles on toilets, to local workers to help improve local livelihoods.
- [Tippy Tap] Tippy Tap, a simple handwashing device, had a problem that if it broke or fell down, it would not be used. Although it can be made easily and inexpensively using materials found in the village, still more improvement is needed to ensure its continued use.



Example of positive deviance: toilets are not only well cleaned and kept clean, but also deodorized/scented by burning locally available incense.

- [Consideration and observation of social culture] Installation of locally appropriate hand washing facilities, such as consideration for the customs of Muslims, is necessary. When investigating how people wash their hands, it is also important to directly observe handwashing facilities and handwashing practices, not only through interviews and questionnaires, because residents tend to answer what is socially desirable in interviews and questionnaires.
- [Importance of encouraging awareness] Approaches to promote "awareness" of the importance of sanitation in residents' lives have been effective, and have led to voluntary activities such as improvement of sanitary environment at water places in villages and hygiene club activities in schools. However, in order to ensure the sustainability of these activities, continuous monitoring and support to them are necessary, and it is essential to encourage government agencies to take action, including budgetary measures.

Awareness-raising activities in cooperation with Japanese companies and alumni associations of former trainees

From October to November 2020, JICA Indonesia Office, in collaboration with the Ministry of Health in Indonesia and Association of 21st century Indonesia-Japan Friendship Program (KAPPIJA21), distributed hygiene products to public health centers and KAPPIJA21 branches, and created an educational video on preventive measures in order to contribute to COVID-19 countermeasures.

For the distribution of hygiene items, 3,000 sets of a hand soap provided by Kao Indonesia and an eye mask, a cloth mask with the JICA logo, a hand sanitizer, a set of a fork, a spoon and a straw, and an infection prevention leaflet including encouragement of handwashing prepared by the Ministry of Health were provided in a bag with the JICA logo. We hope that these supplies will contribute to maintaining hygiene for people working on the front lines of the fight against COVID-19.

In addition, an educational video was created in collaboration with KAPPIJA21, which calls for wearing masks, handwashing and social distancing in an easy to understand manner, and has been widely spread on Facebook and YouTube (as of December 15, 2020, the video has been viewed over 200,000 times on Facebook and over 2,500 times on YouTube). We hope that this video will further raise awareness of hygiene and help prevent COVID-19 and other infectious diseases.
