Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) has been adopted in September 2015, calling for governments to "leave no one behind" in development. Targets should be met for all nations and people and for all segments of society. However many persons with intellectual disabilities (PWIDs), living in developing countries, have been suffering from poverty and without equal chances. many cannot reach the specialized supports and many local residents are unaware of the human rights of PWIDs. Through this program, participants will analyze the situation of PWID in their countries/areas, learn the current situation of PWIDs in Japan, analyze the "Community-based approach" to support PWIDs, and formulate/implement an Action Plan to improve the situation of PWIDs in respective countries/areas.
