<p>Under the development of globalization, the role of Customs has been increasingly important not only for an individual economy, but also for the entire international community. Traditionally, Customs administrations have looked at their national issues such as collecting their revenue as well as protecting their borders. Recently, Customs administrations have been facing new challenges, such as increasing threat to peace and security and transnational organized crime, including more sophisticated smuggling activity. Responding to these changes, international standards, including the WCO Revised Kyoto Convention and WCO Framework of Standards, are drawn up and best practices, such as risk management and post clearance audit, are identified. Therefore, taking into account the environmental changes and global standards tendency, respective country is required to follow these situations and to review its institution continually to carry out proper Customs administrations.</p>
