To understand the actual plans, organizations, systems and management practices (community participation) involved in sustainable forest management by the national and local (Hokkaido) governments of Japan. 2. To understand model forestry activities and timber utilization with community participation and their technologies conducted by municipal governments, private citizens, corporate organizations, and forest cooperatives in Japan. 3. To understand the systems and model activities for nature conservation and sanctuary management with the participation of local communities in Japan. 4. To understand international discussions, methods and activities concerning the significance of the consideration on livelihood necessities and participation of local communities towards sustainable forest management. 5.
