**Outline**

It is essential to effectively support the independent and sustainable development of the local fisheries that are production bases for the officers concerned with fisheries to implement the policies for the development of national fisheries. So the officers in the national and local governments concerned with fishery administration are required to have a broad range of knowledge, deep insights, and great sense of balance in order to address the above-mentioned complex and varied internal conditions and external requests. In recent years, it is increasingly required that the enhancement of administrative capacities toward the promotion of local fisheries, which are becoming important bases for the sustainable development of the fisheries sector.  
 The purpose of this course is, from the perspectives above, based on various findings in the fisheries in Japan, to develop practical capacities that contribute to sustainable promotion of local fisheries and related industries.
