To understand the support measures for trafficked person by non-governmental organizations in Japan</p> <p>3. To extract and analyze each country’ s good practices and issues by identifying necessary procedures for prevention, prosecution, protection and support for trafficked persons, and roles of relevant organizations in each process</p> <p>4. To consider measures for improving the current regional networking on anti-trafficking in persons by understanding and analyzing its situation</p> <p>5. To develop action plans for improving each country’ s measures against Trafficking in Persons and strengthening regional and domestic network, based on the module outputs 1～4 above.</p>		<p>【Target Organization】</p> <p>Governmental and non-governmental organizations related to anti-Trafficking in Persons</p> <p>【Target Group】</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Officials at the rank of assistant director or higher involved in formulation of anti-Trafficking in Persons policies in related government ministry or agency.
