This program aims at formulation of guideline for Public Involvement Process in public works projects with effort to involve participation of citizens from the planning stage of projects taking into account environmental and social consideration view points; in order to resolve troubles such as relocation, land acquisition and compensation, then contribute to smooth implementation of projects.
