Understand the current issues on Japanese perinatal and neonatal health care service and know how medical staff make an approach to the problems through case studies and observations on how the actors collaborate with each other.<br/>4. Formulate a feasible and efficient draft action plan on the improvement of perinatal and neonatal health care service for each participant's institution.<br/>5. Core phase in Japan<br/>(1) Learning how to make an action plan through PCM workshop soon after arriving in Japan.<br/>(2) Sharing of information with the lecturers and other participants through presentation of an inception report.<br/>(3) Lectures on the history of maternal and child health care system in Japan.<br/>(4) Lectures and discussions on various topics on perinatal, neonatal and child health care.<br/>(5) Lectures on MCH handbook and immunization programs.<br/>(6) Observation at clinical sites (parents class, neonatal resuscitation, health check for one month old baby, etc.)<br/>(7) Lectures and facility tours on maternal and child health, which is conducted at health organizations and primary medical institutions<br/>(8) Preparation and presentation of an action plan.</p> <p>3.
