Since anti-Trafficking in Persons has become serious in Asian countries, it must be tackled promptly and accurately. However, it is impossible to tackle with it by only one country. Establishing network as a wide area issue is essential. This course aims to enhance mutual understanding on anti-Trafficking in Persons especially prevention and protection and to promote more effective regional cooperation.

<p>【Objective】 Participants are expected to consider improvement measures against Trafficking in Persons, particularly those in the field of prevention, protection of trafficked persons and support for them, and to strengthen their regional and domestic network through understanding measures and experiences of Japan and other participating countries.</p> <p>【Outcome】 1. To understand the Japanese government's measures against Trafficking in Persons. 2. To understand the support measures for trafficked persons taken by non-governmental organizations in Japan. 3. To extract and analyze each country's good practices and issues by identifying necessary procedures for prevention, prosecution, protection and support for trafficked persons, and roles of relevant organizations in each process. 4. To consider measures for improving the current regional networking on anti-trafficking in persons by understanding and analyzing its situation. 5. To develop action plans for improving each country's measures against Trafficking in Persons and strengthening regional and domestic network, based on the module outputs 1~4 above.</p>	<p>【Target Organization】 Governmental and non-governmental organizations related to anti-Trafficking in Persons</p> <p>【Target Group】 A. be an official at the rank of assistant director or higher involved in formulation of anti-Trafficking in Persons policies in related government ministry or agency.
